### KING PRAWNS

*Melicertus latisulcatus*

SIZES: 6/10 11/15 16/20 15/25 21/30

Shark Bay King Prawns are renowned for their beautiful rainbow tail, light colour and sweet salty taste. They are extremely versatile and can be used in a wide variety of cuisines.



### TIGER PRAWN

*Penaeus esculentus*

SIZES: 6/10 11/15 16/20 15/25 21/30

Shark Bay Tiger Prawns have a rich flavour and a firm texture. Renowned for their vibrant red stripes, they are perfect to cook in the shell.



### SCALLOP

*Melicertus latisulcatus*

SIZES: 6/10 11/15 16/20 15/25 21/30

A scallop is a bivalve – a mollusc with a hinged shell. Several species occur off the coast of Western Australia but only the southern saucer scallop (*Plastrum lineatum*), is abundant enough to support a commercial fishery.
